Turn for Rules Sheet

Haunted House 2020 Rules

Please read and sign this rule sheet and turn it in with your permission slip.

- * Jeans and tennis shoes must be worn at all times at the Hallows (no open toe or soft sole shoes allowed).
- * No smoking **anywhere** on the premises, including outdoors or across the street. Smoking by those under 21 is illegal...just a reminder!!!
- * No leaving the Hallows premises/grounds after you are there for the night, unless you have received permission from your staff team leader. If you are leaving early to go home, or because you don't feel well, you must tell a Youth Go staff member.
- * No leaving your assigned area without permission from your staff group leader. This includes restroom visits, breaks, or going to visit friends in other parts of the Hallows.
- * All electronic devices (including cellphones, iPods, MP3 players, and handheld video games) are not allowed to be turned on inside of the Hallows. They may be used before you sign-in, while you are on break, and when you have left for the night; except for emergencies.
- * No swearing or talking about inappropriate subject matter.
- * No physical or verbal fighting with anyone.
- * Do no bring dangerous objects such as lighters, knives, or weapons of any kind to the Hallows.
- * No kissing, hugging, sitting on each other's laps, or any type of romantic behavior at the event. This is Halloween, not Valentine's Day.
- * You must be in the group you are assigned and play the character you are assigned. Changing groups is not negotiable.
- * Costumes are a must. Youth will come in costume and make-up or mask and not share items with anyone else. Youth are required to wear a cloth or disposable PPE mask that covers their nose and mouth. This PPE mask can be worn in conjunction with haunted house style make-up or a scary mask.
- * No touching the customers touring the hallows for any reason. If someone touches or hits you on purpose, let a staff member know and security will handle it.
- * No speaking disrespectfully to the customers or talking inappropriately to them.
- * If you have a concern, or need help with anything – feeling sick, transportation, want to go on break, having a problem with someone – go to a Youth Go staff person, not an adult volunteer. The volunteers are here to help with security, construction, food service, etc. They are not trained in working with youth.
- * You must be at the Hallows by **5:30, no earlier or later**, and stay until the final group of customers has left the woods. Coming late and leaving early is not okay; except for emergencies. Please have your ride arranged beforehand and make sure they are there at **10:00!** Youth will leave the woods as soon as the last group of customers finishes going through the woods. Ticket sales do end at 10:00pm.

I have read and agree to follow the rules listed above. I realize that if I break any of these rules, I may not be able to participate further in the Hallows.

Informed Consent for Youth Go Programming 2020 During COVID-19

Dear Youth Go Families,

We are so excited to be able to open Youth Go's doors. We miss everyone and are eager to meet any new youth that will soon find us, and explore what Youth Go has to offer. This document contains important information about our decision (Youth Go & your child/ren) to resume in-person services in light of the COVID-19 public health crisis. Please read this carefully and let us know if you have any questions. When you sign this document, it will be an official agreement between us.

Decision to Participate in Youth Go Programming Face-to-Face

We have agreed to meet in person at Youth Go or within our community. If there is a resurgence of the pandemic or if other health concerns arise, it may require us to close our doors again and return to virtual programming.

Risks of Opting for In-Person Services

You understand that by allowing your child/ren to participate with Youth Go's in person programming, you are assuming the risk of exposure to the coronavirus (or other public health risk). This risk may increase if your child travels by public transportation, cab, or ridesharing service.

Your Responsibility to Minimize Your Child/ren's Exposure

To obtain services in person, you agree to take certain precautions which will help keep everyone (your child/ren, your family, Youth Go Staff members, our families, and other youth participants and their families) safer from exposure, sickness and possible death. If you do not adhere to these safeguards, it may result in your child not being able to participate in face-to-face programming provided by Youth Go.

- You will only allow your child to participate in Youth Go programming if they are symptom free.
- We will take your child's temperature as they enter our building. If it is elevated (100 Fahrenheit or more), or if they have other symptoms of the coronavirus, Youth Go staff will ask your child to return to your vehicle, and not return until they are symptom free for 72 hours. We ask that you wait in your vehicle in front of our building until you get an "all clear" wave from our staff. Youth may walk or ride their bikes/scooter/skateboard etc. to Youth Go, in this case we will ask the child to return home the same way they arrived.
- Youth will wash their hands or use alcohol-based hand sanitizer when they enter the building (provided).
- Youth will be provided a personal cloth face mask that they will wear while they are participating in activities within our center. Youth may remove them for safety concerns while outside and participating in physical activity. Youth Go staff will wash and reissue the same mask to each participant every time they attend our programming. Masks are not allowed to be taken home.
- Youth will work diligently to keep a distance of 6 feet when possible from other youth and staff, and refrain from all physical contact (e.g. no shaking hands, hugs, etc.)
- Youth will try not to touch their face or eyes with their hands. If they do, youth will be directed to wash or sanitize their hands. Updated 6/6/2020
- Youth will not be allowed to bring any personal items from home other than a labelled water bottle and their cell phone. (No personal gaming systems, video game controllers, board games, etc.)
- Youth participants will be the only ones allowed to enter our building. If you are picking up, we ask that you call us at 920-722-1435 and we'll send your child out.

- If a resident of your home tests positive for the virus, you will immediately let Youth Go know and we will then discuss how we can support your child/ren until all residents are 72 hours symptom free.
- Ultimately, Youth Go will have many new guidelines for everyone's health and safety. We will be gentle and kind but will expect youth to adhere to all of the staff's directions.

Youth Go may change the above precautions if additional local, state or federal orders or guidelines are published. If that happens, Youth Go will contact families, as well as post on all of our social media outlets.

For “**The Hallows**” youth should arrive at Memorial Park at 5:30pm on Friday and Saturday and have their rides pick them up at 10:00pm. Youth will leave the woods as soon as the last group of customers finishes going through the woods. Ticket sales do end at 10:00pm.

Important Rules and Safety Procedures

- * A cloth or disposable PPE mask that covers the nose and mouth must be worn by all youth, volunteers, staff, and customers. Youth should show up wearing their PPE mask or face covering.
- * Youth need to come dressed in costume and have their make-up or scary mask already done. No costumes, scary masks, or make-up will be provided.
- * Dinner will not be provided. Youth should plan to eat before arriving.
- * Each night, youth will receive one break where they may use the bathroom, check their phone, and eat a snack that will be provided.
- * Youth are not allowed to touch each other. Scares should be planned so that youth do not touch each other and keep physical distance from each other.
- * Youth are not allowed to touch customers. If someone touches or hits you on purpose, let a staff member know and security will handle it. Scares should be planned to keep physical distance from customers.
