



## What is Youth Go?

Youth Go is an after-school program that offers a variety of activities and opportunities to youth in grades 5-12 in the Fox Cities! There are no membership fees and everything that takes place at Youth Go is FREE. Youth are not required to come any certain number of days each week and they don't have to stay the entire time. Youth Go is a drop-in center and our goal is to provide a safe and supportive place for youth to spend their time after school and in the evenings. We believe it is important to provide quality programming, interesting activities, qualified staff, and a place to have fun!

## When can you come to Youth Go?

**Middle School Program** (youth in 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade)  
Mondays – Wednesday from 3:00-5:30pm  
Fridays from 3:00-7:30pm

**High School Program** (youth in 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade)  
Mondays-Thursdays 6:00-9:30pm  
Fridays from 3:00-7:30pm



7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students are able to attend our Middle School and/or High School Program

## What does Youth Go offer to Middle School Students?

### Transportation

During the school year students with a completed transportation permission slip can get a ride from Maplewood, Horace Mann, and Shattuck after school on Monday-Wednesday and Friday.

# Information about Youth Go's Programs:

## Recreation Program

- \***Daily Drop-in Center**- a safe and supportive place for all youth.
- \***Family Nights**- four gatherings throughout the year full of fun, friendship, and food.
- \***Haunted House** – volunteer as a scare-actor with Youth Go's Haunted House Events. Make-up, costumes, and training provided. You just have to show up with a positive attitude. Fridays and Saturdays in October from 5-10pm. Permission slip is required!

## Education Program

- \***Study Stars**- supervised homework time for 30 minutes at Youth Go Monday-Wednesday.
- \***Homework Club**- homework help is provided at both Middle Schools in Neenah - Horace Mann and Shattuck - on Thursdays from 3:15-5pm.
- \***Homework Lab**- a quiet place offered nightly at the center during our high school hours.
- \***Monthly speakers** on topics such as career exploration, the arts, or interesting hobbies.

## Support and Wellness Program

- \***One-on-one support** from Youth Go staff members whenever you need someone to listen.
- \***Peer Discussion Groups**- groups offered in 3 month sessions throughout the year.
- \***Nightly Meals**- dinner is offered nightly at the center.
- \***Monthly speakers** on topics such as healthy relationships and making healthy choices.
- \***Community Service Club**- volunteer opportunities available Wednesdays from 4-5:30. Transportation is provided and a Permission Slip is required.

## Current COVID Protocols in Place:

Currently, a COVID waiver is required for participation in Youth Go's programs. With the start of the school year masks will be recommended (and provided) but not required. We reserve the right to make changes to our COVID policies any time based on the spread of COVID in our community and any direction given by the local, state, or national government.
