

2023 was a year of excitement at Youth Go. We had changes in staff and purchased a third van, to support the continued increase in attendance and participation numbers. Thank you to all of the people and places that supported the work and mission of Youth Go. Every gift, at every dollar amount, makes an impact and helps us to provide youth with a safe and supportive place full of opportunities, support and fun!

1,615 unduplicated young people were served in 2023. — Youth Go Cares — 409 walked through the doors and participated in our in-center programming. — Youth Go Serves —— 1,206 youth participated in out of center programming. Youth Go is Friendly — From 2022 to 2023, the total attendance increased from 4,402 to 4,922. That is an increase of almost 12%. Youth Go was a busy place in 2023. Youth Go is Safe — 126 unique youth participated in one or more of the 201 offered creative arts activities for a total attendance of 1,145.

167 unique youth have been nourished through one or more of the 251 meals served at Youth Go with a total of 2,395 meals provided.

163 unique youth have taken part in one or more of the 378 recreational activities with a total attendance of 2,255.

96 unique middle school aged youth have taken part in one or more of the 107 Study Star homework sessions for a total attendance of 1,277.
