By signing this form, I am stating that my child has no medical or emotional concerns that would be triggered by working in a haunted attraction set in a wooded environment that may feature flashing lights, fog machines, dust/allergens, theater makeup, loud noise, and simulated scares and gore.

I hereby grant permission to Youth Go representatives to take and use photographs and digital images of my child for use in news releases, educational materials, printed and electronic publications, or Websites. I agree that my child's name and identity may be revealed in descriptive text or commentary in connection with the image(s). I authorize the use of these images without compensation to me. Hallows 2026 Rules

Please read and sign this rule sheet and turn it in with your permission slip.

- * Jeans and tennis shoes must be worn at all times at the Hallows (no crocs, open toe or soft sole shoes allowed).
- * No smoking **anywhere** on the premises. Smoking by those under 21 is illegal...just a reminder!!!
- * No leaving the Hallows premises/grounds after you are there for the night, unless you have received permission from your staff member leader. If you are leaving early to go home, or because you don't feel well, you must tell a Youth Go staff member.
- * No leaving your assigned area without permission from your staff group leader. This includes restroom visits, breaks, or going to visit friends in other parts of the Hallows.
- * All electronic devices (including cellphones, iPods, MP3 players, and handheld video games) should not be used inside of the Hallows. They may be used before you enter the woods for the event, while you are on break, and when you have left for the night; except for emergencies.
- * No swearing or talking about inappropriate subject matter.
- * No physical or verbal fighting with anyone.
- * Do not bring dangerous objects such as lighters, knives, or weapons (including props) of any kind to the Hallows.
- * No kissing, hugging, sitting on each other's laps, or any type of romantic behavior at the event. This is Halloween, not Valentine's Day.
- * You are expected to be in the group you are assigned, unless circumstances dictate otherwise. Any reasons for switching must be approved by the Youth Go staff member in your group.
- * Costumes are a must. Youth may come in a pre-approved costume and make-up or mask.
- * No touching the customers touring the hallows for any reason. If someone touches or hits you on purpose, let a staff member know and security will handle it.
- * No speaking disrespectfully to the customers or talking inappropriately to them.
- * If you have a concern, or need help with anything – feeling sick, transportation, want to go on break, having a problem with someone – go to a Youth Go staff person, not an adult volunteer. The volunteers are here to help with security, construction, food service, etc. They are not trained in working with youth.
- * Please be at the Hallows by **5:00, no earlier or later**, and stay until the final group of customers has left the woods. Coming late and leaving early is not okay; except for emergencies. Please have your ride arranged beforehand and make sure they are there at **10:15**. Youth will leave the woods as soon as the last group of customers finishes going through the woods. Ticket sales do end at 10:00pm.

I have read and agree to follow the rules listed above. I realize that if I break any of these rules, I may not be able to participate further in the Hallows.

Scare School – September 17th

The Hallows – September 25th, 26th, October 2nd, 3rd, 9th, and 10th

For “**The Hallows**” youth should arrive at Memorial Park, 1131 Tullar Rd in Neenah at **5:00pm, no earlier or later**, on Friday and Saturday and have their rides pick them up at **10:15pm**. Staff members will not be available to provide supervision to youth outside of this timeframe. Youth will leave the woods as soon as the last group of customers finishes going through the woods. Ticket sales do end at 10:00pm.

Important Rules and Safety Procedures

* Youth should plan to come dressed in a pre-approved costume and have their make-up or scary mask already done. Minimal costumes, scary masks, or make-up will be provided. Talk to a Youth Go staff member in advance for costume or make-up help. Please avoid using well known characters from horror franchises (Freddy, Jason, Michael Myers, Leatherface, etc.)

* **Dinner will be provided.** Youth need to come prepared to get into costume and make-up quickly so that there is time to eat, go over rules, and get into the woods in time to scare customers.

* Each night, youth will receive one break where they may use the bathroom, check their phone, and eat a snack that will be provided.

* Youth are not allowed to touch each other. Scares should be planned so that youth do not touch each other and keep physical distance from each other.

* Youth are not allowed to touch customers. If someone touches or hits you on purpose, let a staff member know and security will handle it. Scares should be planned to keep physical distance from customers. *Youth Go reserves the right to make changes to safety procedures as needed.
